Today's Liturgy: As in Matthew's Gospel, Luke's version of the Sermon gets under way with the Beatitudes. In Matthew it is the "Sermon on the Mount". In Luke Jesus descends from a mountain and teaches the crowds at ground level. Here, each 'beatitude/blessing' addressed to the poor and the suffering is countered by a warning to the rich and selfabsorbed. Luke's version displays more typical traits of how a Jewish teacher of the Law might work: comparing and contrasting traits—poverty and riches, hunger and plenty, tears and rejoicing!
